

Enabling or disabling completion requirements

When you publish a course in Course Builder, you are asked to select if you would like the project to be tracked in one of three ways:

- 1) Each unit to be tracked as a separate item (multiple SCOs)
- 2) Each module to be tracked as a separate item (multiple SCOs)
- 3) The project to be tracked as a single item (single SCO)

If the course you are in the process of publishing contains several units, and you select either option 2 or option 3 above, you will also be asked if you would like to require that each unit be completed before the next unit can be studied in a step similar to the one below:

Step 3: Please indicate if you would like to require that each unit be completed before the next unit can be studied: -

NOTE: It has been detected that your project contains 2 different units which contain assessments pools. If you have specified that the scores from the assessment pools in more than one of these units should count towards the overall score, it may be possible for a user to obtain a score sufficient to pass the course as a whole even though they may not have passed each scored assessment. Therefore, it is particularly recommended that this setting be enabled for this project.

At this point you can make your selection according to your requirements.

If you are re-purposing a course that previously had completion requirement enabled, but you do not want this to be enforced in your version of the course, make the amendments you need to the screens and course structure.

When you publish your course, ensure that you select 'Do not enable this completion requirement' and the change will take effect.
