

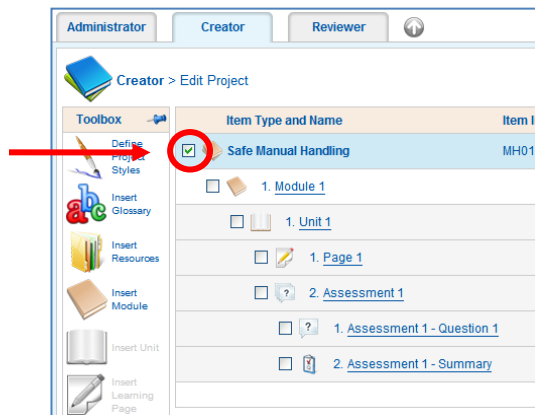
Creating Colour Styles

If you need to use a specific colour frequently when creating materials in Course Builder, you don't necessarily need to manually define it for each object in your screens.

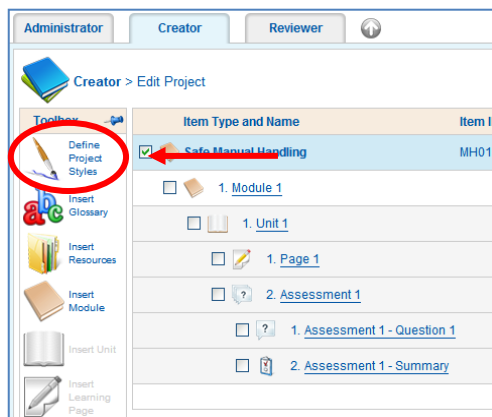
Instead, you can create a new colour style which will then be readily available from your colour picker.

To do this:

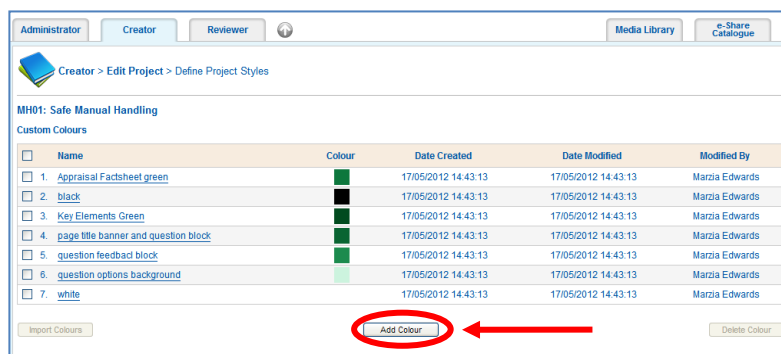
- 1) Place a tick in the Project selection box in the course structure:



- 2) Click on the **Define Project Styles** button in your **Toolbox**:



- 3) You will be taken to a screen that displays any colour styles already available to your project. To add a new colour style, click on the **Add Colour** button:



- 4) You will be moved to the screen that allows you to define the new colour style. Add the name you want to give to your style in the **Colour Name** field, then use the slider and the **Colour** box to select the colour you need.

Alternatively, you can enter the HSB, RGB or HEX values in the boxes available.

- 5) As you make your selections, the colour style that will be added to your project is displayed in the **Preview** box. When you are happy with the selection, click on the **Save** button to save your new style.
