


Adding Units

Projects are built using 3 levels of hierarchy, which allow the project to be built in manageable chunks that reflect the main and sub-topics of the project content. A module is the highest level of topic arrangement in your project. Units are the topics that are contained within each module. You may wish to arrange a module into a number of supporting units, to ensure that the course contents are bite-size.


When you create a brand new project, by default this will contain one module, which will in turn contain one unit.

To add a unit to a module within your project:

1) Place a tick in the Module selection box in the course structure:




2) Click on the Insert Unit button in your Toolbox:





- 3) Your screen will move to the **Insert Unit** page. This is where you need to enter the details of your unit. In the **Unit name** box, type the title for the new unit.
 - In the **Description** box, add details about the contents of the new unit. Remember that these details will be visible to your end users.

When all the details have been added, click on the Save button to complete the process.



The new unit will be added at the bottom of the module you selected:
