

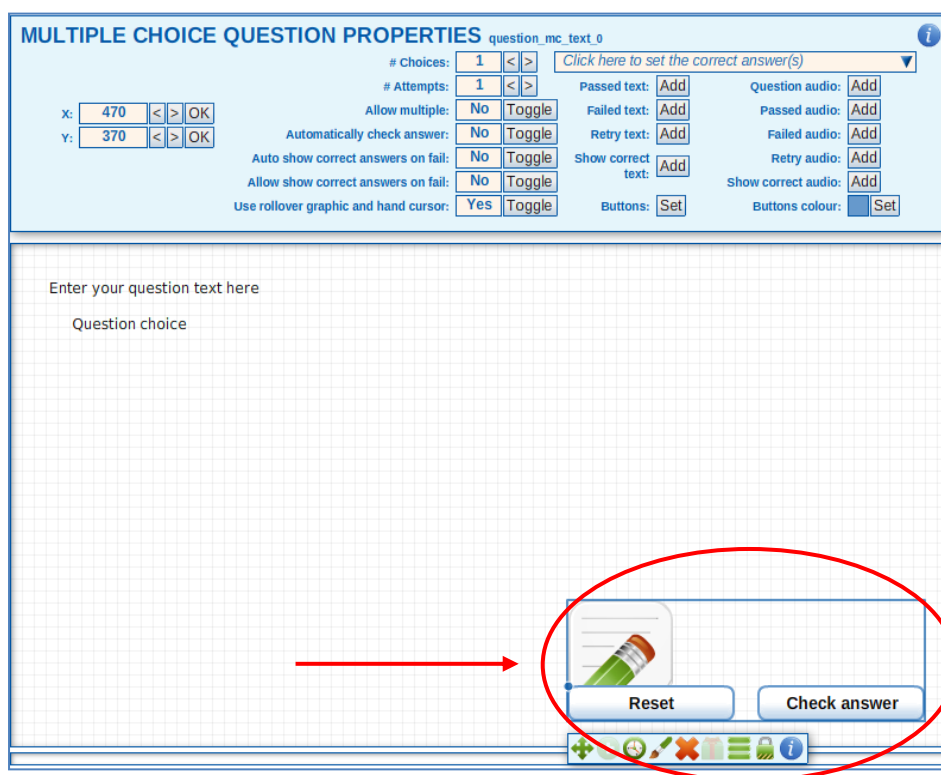
Displaying the correct answer when your learners answer a question incorrectly can be a very powerful teaching tool.

In a multiple choice question, by default the learners will not be able to see what the correct answer is when they answer the question incorrectly.

This setting can be changed so that the correct answer will be highlighted automatically, or the learners will be allowed to manually display the correct answer by clicking a button:

1) To display the correct answer automatically:

a) Select the question object so that its properties are displayed in the Properties Panel:



b) In the Properties Panel, toggle the **Auto show correct answer on fail** setting to **Yes**:



2) To allow your learners to display the correct answer manually:

a) In the Properties Panel, toggle the **Allow show correct answer on fail** setting to **Yes**:

Note: This option will display a **Show Correct** button on screen when the question is answered incorrectly.

Remember: When you enable either the manual or automatic **Show Correct** option, it is good practice to also add some feedback which explains that the correct answer being highlighted on screen.
