

If you have implemented the option to allow users to display what the correct answer is after they answer a question incorrectly, you will also be able to display some additional text to explain that the right answer is highlighted and any additional information you would like to give.

To implement this option:

- 1) Click on **Show correct text** in the question's properties panel:

Note 1: The **Show correct** feedback will only be displayed if you enable the option called **Allow show correct answers on fail**. If you enable the **Auto show correct answer on fail** option instead, the **Show correct** text will not be displayed, so any additional feedback should be added to the **Failed text** feedback.
