DUPLICATING OBJECTS

You can use the Object Toolbar 'duplicate' icon to duplicate an object by using the mouse. You can combine that with holding the [SHIFT] key to duplicate the object in place.

[CTRL] +[D]

Duplicate an object

[CTRL] + [SHIFT] +[D]

Duplicate an object in place (duplicated object has same position as original)

DELETING OBJECTS

You can use the Object Toolbar 'delete' icon to delete an object using the mouse. You can combine that with holding the [SHIFT] key to delete the object without the confirmation prompt.

[DELETE KEY]

Delete an object

[SHIFT] + [DELETE KEY]

Delete an object without confirmation prompt

MOVING OBJECTS

[ARROW KEY LEFT]

Nudge selected object(s) 1 pixel to left

[ARROW KEY RIGHT]

Nudge selected object(s) 1 pixel to right

[ARROW KEY UP]

Nudge selected object(s) 1 pixel up

[ARROW KEY DOWN]

Nudge selected object(s) 1 pixel down

[SHIFT] + [ARROW KEY]

Nudge selected object(s) 10 pixels in direction of [ARROW KEY]

[SHIFT] + [CTRL] + [ARROW KEY]

Nudge selected object(s) a distance equal to the grid width or height depending on [ARROW KEY]. For example if grid is set to 50W x 10H moving it left or right would mean moving it 50 pixels and moving it up or down would mean moving it 10 pixels from current position. This does not automatically snap an object to the grid.

CYCLING THROUGH OBJECTS

[TAB]

Selects next object in screen according to an internal list of objects in the screen. Handy for selecting objects behind other objects. Individual objects in groups cannot be selected this way.

[SHIFT] + [TAB]

Selects previous object in screen according to an internal list of objects in the screen. Handy for selecting objects behind other objects. Individual objects in groups cannot be selected this way.

GENERAL SHORTCUTS

[ESC]

Deselects any object(s) currently selected.

[SHIFT] + [CTRL]

Highlights all objects in screen if no object is currently selected. Blue highlights will be drawn around each object and orange / amber highlights will be drawn around any object that require a click for the screen to be completed.

[SHIFT]

When pressing and holding the mouse on a button labeled either '<' or '>' (increase or decrease values) it will automatically repeat at a slow pace. By holding the [SHIFT] key before pressing the button the repeats will be significantly faster, allowing you to change values quicker.
