

Automatically Check Multiple Choice Questions

When you add a multiple choice question to your screen, by default the learners of your course will need to click on the 'Check Answer' button after selecting their answer for the feedback to the question to appear.

However, if you prefer for the answer to be checked automatically, without the learners having to click on any button, you can do so.

Select the question object so that its properties are displayed in the **Properties** toolbar.
