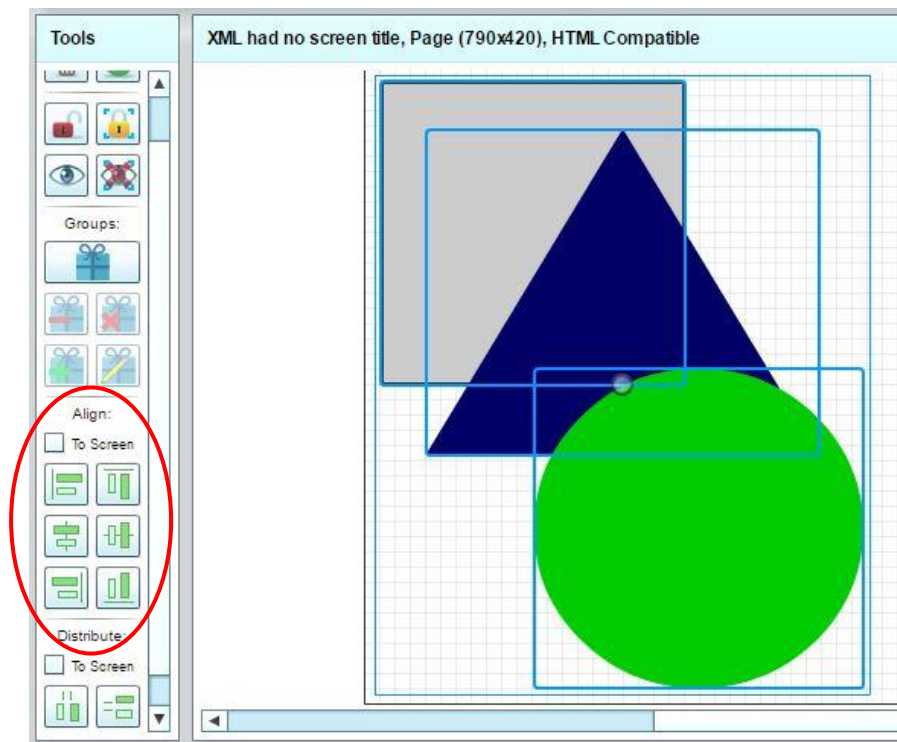


Aligning Groups of Objects

If your screen contains several objects placed in different positions and you need to align them all either to the screen or in relation to each other's positions, Nimbus allows you to do this with one action which will apply to all the objects selected.

Start by selecting all the objects you want to align. Keep the **Shift** key pressed on your keyboard while you click on all the objects you want to align.

When several objects are selected, options to align will be available in the **Tools** toolbar.



Place a tick in the **To Screen** box if you wish to align the objects to the screen, rather than the selection boundaries of the selected objects.

You then have the option of left, centre or right-aligning on the horizontal axis, and/or top, centre or bottom-aligning on the vertical axis.
